



JUMPSHOT 3x3: CAMPUS OPEN RULES & REGULATIONS

1 EVENT BACKGROUND

Jumpshot 3x3: Campus Open is a FIBA-endorsed event in Singapore, and Pink Warriors 3x3 (hereinafter referred to as the “Event”) is organised by Jumpshot Arena Pte. Ltd. (referred to as the “Organiser” with its respective parent companies, subsidiaries, and affiliated parties).

The **Jumpshot 3x3: Campus Open** is the high-stakes "Search Phase" of the Pink Warriors Season 5 journey. Hosted at the iconic ACS (Barker Road), this open-entry tournament strips away the barriers to entry, allowing any school team in Singapore to prove their mettle on a professional-grade court. It is a true meritocracy where reputation means nothing and performance means everything.

The Stake: The Golden Ticket. Only the Top 6 teams earn the right to advance to the Grand Finale at *SCAPE.

1.1 There are six (6) categories in this tournament:

	U16	Aged 15 to 16 years old in 2026 Born in 2010 or 2011
FEMALE	U12	Aged 10 to 12 years old in 2026 Born in 2014, 2015, or 2016
	U14	Aged 13 to 14 years old in 2026 Born in 2012 or 2013
	U16	Aged 15 to 16 years old in 2026 Born in 2010 or 2011

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Each player is allowed to register in only one (1) Team with a maximum of six (6) players.

2.2 Only players with a confirmed FIBA account are allowed to participate. Players can create an account on play.fiba3x3.com.

2.3 Eligibility for each category is based on the birth year based on Clause 1.1

2.4 The Organiser will not be responsible or in any way liable in the event of any dispute arising between the player(s) and / or any organisations.

2.5 Participants must be physically fit and are not suffering from any chronic or infectious diseases that may endanger other participants.

2.6 The Organiser reserves the right to reject the registration of any team or player(s) at its discretion.

2.7 Upon entering the Event, participants must agree and accept all rules, procedures, and terms (collectively or separately referred to as "the Rules"). The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify any players or teams for infractions of tournament rules and policies.

2.8 In the event of any question or matter arising in relation to eligibility of player(s), which is not expressly provided for in any of the rules governing this tournament, the decision made by the Organiser will be final.

3 TEAM NAME & ELIGIBILITY RULES

The "Same Campus" Rule: To foster peer bonding and school-level rivalry, all six (6) players on a team must be currently enrolled at the same campus or school.

3.1 Team Naming Convention

3.11 Independent Squads: Teams formed by students independently must create an original team name (e.g., "*The Barker Ballers*"). **Independent team names must not include the official name of the school.**

3.12 Official School Teams: Only teams officially submitted and endorsed by the school's physical education department or sports office are permitted to use the **Official School Name** as their team identity.

3.2 International Inclusivity: There are no restrictions on nationality. Any student with a valid Visa or Entry Pass to Singapore is eligible to participate, provided they meet the age category and school enrollment requirements.

4 COMPOSITION OF TEAMS

4.1 Minimum Teams per Category

Each category requires a minimum of **eight (8) teams** to proceed. Only **one Champion Team** will be awarded per category.

4.2 Team Size

Each team must have a **minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6 players**.

4.3 Players on Court

Teams may rotate among their registered players **between games**. However, for each game, **only four (4) players may be fielded**, and these **same four players must remain on court for the entire game**. **No substitutions or player changes are allowed during a game**.

4.4 Player Verification

All players must present a valid **original photo identification document** for verification upon request.

4.5 Team Contact Person

Each team must appoint a **Team Captain or Team Liaison** as the main point of contact (“POC”) with the organiser.

Teams and players are responsible for reading and understanding all Rules & Regulations of the tournament.

4.6 Coaching

Coaching is not allowed during the tournament.

5 REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

5.1 Information on the Event may be found on Jumpshot’s Official website at <https://jumpshot.sg/>.

5.2 Registration Fee for all categories is \$50 per team. The registration fee is non-refundable and must be paid upon registration on Jumpshot’s official website.

5.3 Registration period: May 1 to June 1, 2026, 2026, 2000 hours.

5.4 Teams who have successfully registered for the Event will be announced on the play.fiba3x3.com, event name Jumpshot 3x3: Campus Open, on June 10, 2026.

5.5 All players’ names in each team must be provided upon registration. No substitutions, de-registration, or inclusion of players will be allowed after the registration closing date, unless otherwise approved by the Organiser in writing.

5.6 The team’s name shall comply with the principle of public order and good custom, shall not contain slander, discrimination, or infringement of the interests of any third party, and shall not be randomly changed. In addition, the team’s name shall not be identical to or similar to the name, trademark, trade name, and/or product name of any well-known enterprise (except for legally authorised names or self-owned trademarks).

For any team name deemed as inappropriate by an Organiser, teams shall make an immediate alteration.

5.7 It is the sole responsibility of the Team Captain or Team Liaison to ensure their players are only registered in one (1) team. Submission of ineligible players may result in the team being disqualified from the tournament at the Organiser's discretion.

5.8 Any foreign player in the team must be a holder of a valid passport and ensure that they meet or possess entry requirements as stated by the Singapore Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA).

5.9 Each participant is required to have his/her own insurance (health and accidental). The Organiser and all its respective appointed vendors, agents and employees will not be liable for any injury, accidents, or mishaps throughout the duration of the Event.

6 PRIZES AND AWARDS

6.1 Medals will be awarded to the top 3 teams for all categories.

6.2 One (1) Champion team from each category will be given a complimentary entry [golden ticket] to the Pink Warriors 3x3 Season 5 (July 18-19), only 4 can be registered for the event.

6.3 The top teams awarded must be present for the prize presentation ceremony.

6.4 All players must be properly attired when attending the ceremony (team uniforms and covered shoes). No slippers or sandals are allowed.

7 TOURNAMENT PRECAUTIONARY TERMS

7.1 The Organiser, at their discretion, reserves the right to determine the date, time, and venue of the fixtures for the tournament. All teams shall abide by the Organiser's arrangements and shall not raise objections to them. Teams will concede a walkover if they fail to turn up twenty (20) minutes before the scheduled warm-up time.

7.2 It is mandatory for teams to prepare two (2) sets of jerseys: one (1) dark and one (1) light (white only). Teams must wear identical coloured shorts and tops. Dark shorts are allowed.

7.3 If, for any reason, the team is unable or voluntarily gives up its rights to participate in the next round, the Organiser reserves the right to substitute the team with another team based on its ranking in the tournament.

7.4 The Organiser reserves the right to impose punishment or disqualification, including but not limited to revoking all team players from participating in any tournaments held by Jumpshot Singapore.

7.5 No substitution is allowed for the team, in the event one of the team's players is disqualified.

8 RIGHTS EXEMPTION

8.1 On entering the tournament, participants agree to irrevocably and perpetually grant each of the Organiser and its respective designated parties the right to use all the personal information and all other materials provided or generated by participants in connection with the Event in an unconditional and free manner, including but not limited to participants' name, stage name, portrait, photos taken on site, videos, interview records, comments and remarks on the Event, team names, marks, team logos (hereinafter referred to as "Materials")

8.2 The usage of Materials includes but is not limited to copying, editing, encoding, storage, recording, distribution, rental, exhibition, screening, performance, broadcast, online dissemination, filming, adaptation, translation, compilation and modification. Each of the Organiser reserves the right to delete the Materials during or after the Event and is not responsible for returning them in any form.

9 CONFLICT OF RIGHTS

9.1 Teams/participants are not allowed to arrange/enter into any commercial endorsement agreement with any brands or participate in any brand endorsement activities during the Event without prior written consent from the Organiser. Failure to do so may result in a team's disqualification and the Organiser are not responsible for any direct or indirect losses caused thereby.

10 SUPPLEMENTARY RULES

10.1 If the Event is cancelled or postponed due to rule or order from government or judicial authority whether valid or not or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of any Organiser, the Organiser shall notify the Team Captain or Team Liaison accordingly of such postponement or cancellation.

10.2 The Rules and Regulations are accurate at time of print. The Organiser reserve the right to amend the said Rules and Regulations at any time as it deems fit. The Organiser reserves the right of final interpretation on all the rules, procedures, and annexes.

10.3 No refunds or transfers will be made once payment has been collected or registration has been confirmed. Unless otherwise stated in these Rules & Regulations or by the Organiser, no compensation will be made under any circumstances, including inclement weather or failure to show up for the Event.

11 DECLARATION AND GUARANTEE

All teams, participants and team staffs hereby abide by the terms and commit as follows:

11.1 I shall fully comply with the Rules and Regulations during my participation in the Event.

11.2 I hereby declare all registered information to be accurate and complete. I am able to present my identification to the Organiser prior to the Event for verification purposes. I understand providing false, misleading or inaccurate information about my team and myself may be disqualified from the tournament.

11.3 I hereby declare I am physically fit to participate in the Event and am not suffering from any chronic or infectious diseases that may endanger other participants.

11.4 I shall not breach any Rules and Regulations under law application and no infringement of third-party rights.

11.5 I hereby declare that I am aware of all potential risks of the Event, including the risk of causing bodily injuries, voluntarily participate in the Event, and agree to accept such potential risks.

11.6 I agree to sign Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement of Participants prior to the event (Annex II, hereinafter referred to as the "Release and Waiver", which will be signed during team on-site check in) and deliver the signed Release and Waiver to the Organiser.

11.7 I will assume the responsibilities of all risks arising from participation in the Event. I will not hold the Organiser liable for any loss, damage or cost arising from participation in the Event.

Tournament Type : 3x3 Basketball Tournament

Number of Teams : Minimum eight (8), and up to sixteen (16) teams per category

Team allocation is generated automatically through the FIBA 3x3 event system.

Tournament Format* : Group Round Robin – teams advance to Quarter Finals
Subject to change : Quarter Finals – 4 Teams advance to Semi-Finals
Semi Finals
Finals

At the end of each game, the Team Captain from each team shall review and sign the official score sheet to verify that the game score and the winning team are accurate. Failure to complete this process immediately upon conclusion of the game will be considered an acknowledgment that the score is final and the winning team has been accurately recorded. Once the game results are determined, the recorded result is not subject to change unless approved in writing by a designated tournament official.

13 GAME RULES

13.1 Games are played in 10 minutes running clock. The game clock will not stop during dead ball situations and free throws.

13.2 ONLY three (3) players from each team are eligible to play on the court at any given time.

13.3 A team **must start** with **at least 3 players**. If a team is **reduced to 2 players** (e.g., due to injury or fouling out), **the game cannot continue**, and the team will **forfeit**.

13.4 Timeouts – There will be no timeouts throughout the games during the preliminary rounds except for the semi and finals.

13.5 Tiebreaker Rule – an overtime shall be played. The first team to score 2 points in the overtime wins the game.

13.6 FIBA 3x3 Rules of the Game will be implemented.

14 GAMES SCHEDULES

14.1 The schedule will be updated on the FIBA 3x3 website at least three days prior to the event, i.e. on or before June 10, 2026.
